Beneficiary - Mary's House

Domestic Violence in Australia and around the world is at alarming proportions. The statistics in Australia are very disconcerting!

- * On average 1 woman a week is murdered by her former or current partner as a result of domestic violence;
- * 1 in 4 Australian women have experienced physical or sexual violence by an intimate partner;
- * 1 in 4 women have experienced emotional abuse by an intimate partner.

Many of these women have children in their care – witnessing and/or experiencing violence as a child has a long term impact on their social well being and mental health. Shelters like **Mary's House** offers a temporary but much appreciated solution to this epidemic - https://maryshouse.org.au/

Mary's House is a refuge for women and children escaping domestic violence.

They offer a sanctuary to these families and enable them to start a new, safe life.

Mary's House is a community initiative – it was started by a group of like minded people and continues to be funded and supported through the community, with no government funding. It is a small house enabling 5 families at a time to receive support. They continue to offer outreach services to many residents as they move on to their new lives.

With this in mind, let us do everything within our power to educate, and hopefully in time, help to significantly reduce the incidences of domestic violence.
